

# HDPtHA & PtHA RULES

PtHA rules will be followed and enforced. Knowledge of these rules is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please refer to the PtHA 2013 rulebook for specific rules. All classes will be judged using guidelines set forth in the current rulebook. In absence of specific rules, show management has the final decision.

You must be a current member in good standing of the Pinto Horse Association to earn points.

Membership of HDPtHA is required for both the exhibitor and horse owner to be eligible for yearend awards. You must show in a minimum of 2 shows, and in 3 of the qualifying classes per division to qualify for daily and yearend awards. Horses shown in open classes are not required to belong to any registry.

Registration papers and membership cards, including amateur and youth **MUST BE SHOWN**, for Pinto classes.

Walk Trot Jog riders cannot cross enter in any other performance classes. The Charity Class is open to **ALL** exhibitors, but not in all day fee.

Stallions are not to be exhibited by youths.

## CLASS CHANGES, SCRATCHES & TACK CHANGES

Class changes should be completed (3) classes in advance. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR** or their representative to notify the show office/gate person of classes that have been added or scratched. Please request any tack changes at least (3) classes in advance. Gate adds are welcome.
